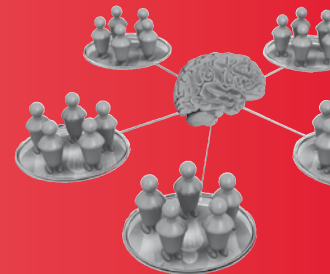

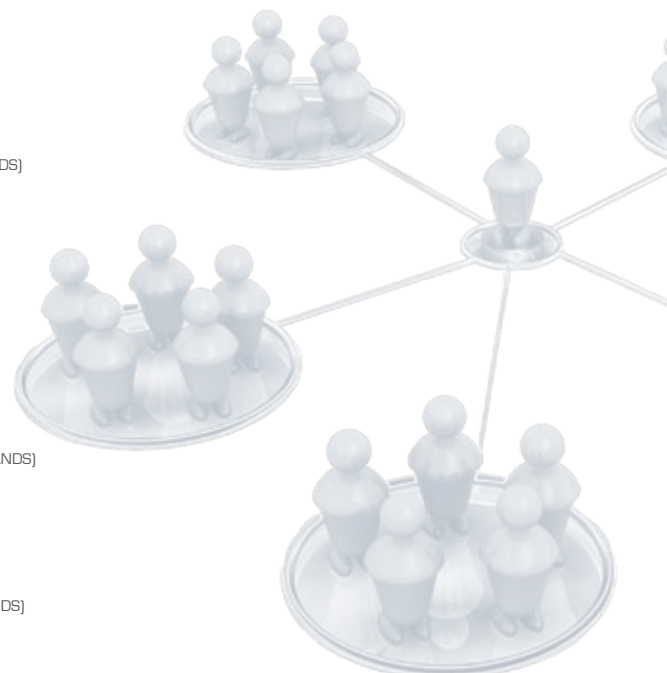

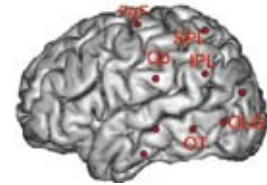
We will also thoroughly discuss how to proceed to SEEG investigations in patients with hypermotor seizures, especially those MRI-negative.
