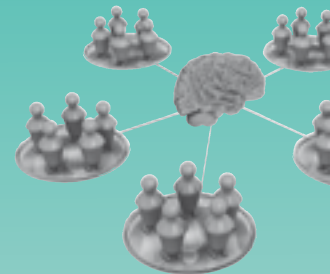

This 8th edition will focus on «The many faces of insulo-perisylvian seizures» and will follow the same organization as that of the seven previous courses.

It will be primarily based on computer-assisted practical training sessions where each attendee can access and analyse numerical neuroimaging and video-EEG/SEEG data, as well as on extensive plenary discussions.

Particular attention will be paid to the ictal clinical picture of the seizures, with the aim of classifying them following both the origin of the discharges (in the different parts of the insula and of the opercular cortex) and the main pathways of propagation.

This theoretical framework will be integrated to the illustrative cases presented

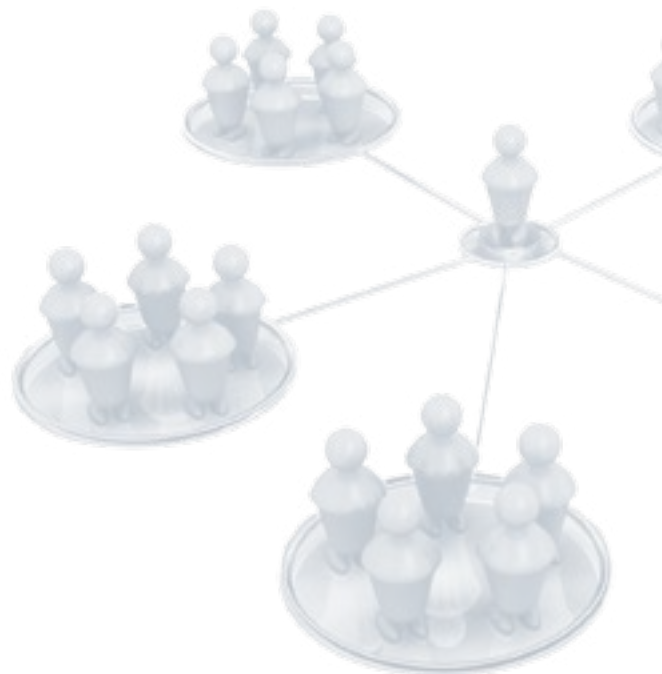
