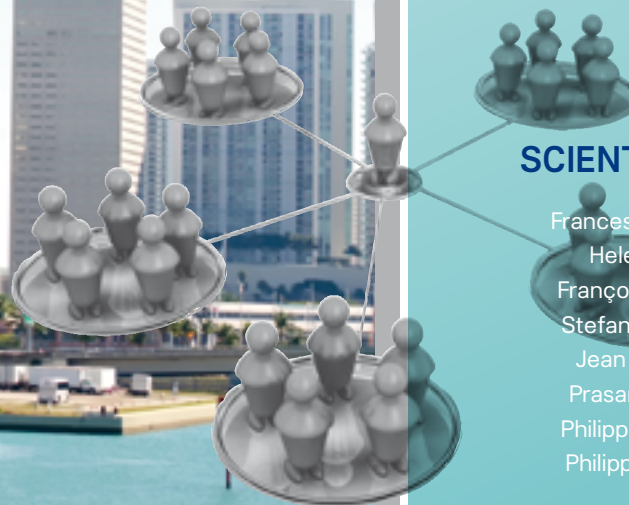

Welcome

Dear colleagues and friends,

On Behalf of the Scientific Committee, we are glad to announce the eighth North-American Training Course in Stereo-ElectroEncephaloGraphy (SEEG), which will be held October 20 to 24 in Miami.

This course follows the cycle started in 2012 with Temporal and Temporal 'plus' epilepsies, followed by Frontal lobe epilepsies (2013), Posterior cortex epilepsies (2014), Epilepsies associated with Malformations of cortical development (2015), Hypermotor seizures (2016), Epileptic spasms (2017) and bilateral asymmetric tonic seizures (2018).

This new course will deal with Versive seizures, i.e. seizures characterised by a prominent version of the eyes and/or head, as well as gyratory seizures.

As for previous courses, participants will primarily train on real patient's data under the supervision of SEEG experts from the experienced centers of Calgary, Grenoble, Lausanne, Lyon, London, Marseille, Miami, Milano, Montreal, Rennes and Rome.

After reviewing digitized video-scalp-EEG, MRI, and PET data, each group will have to decide on whether to perform and how to design an optimal SEEG investigation. They will then review and analyze SEEG findings, and eventually recommend a surgical decision. Each group conclusion will be thoroughly discussed during plenary sessions.

Plenary sessions will also include a key note lecture from Mike Duchovny, as well as lectures addressing the physiology of the oculomotor system (Christopher Park), stimulation-induced versive signs (Roberto Mai), semiology of versive movements in frontal (François Dubeau), temporal/temporal+ (Dang Nguyen) and posterior (Stefano Francione) epilepsies, and its age-dependent characteristics (Helen Cross). A 2-hour workshop led by Francesco Cardinale will illustrate how to optimally coregistrate SEEG electrodes with neuroimaging data using mainstream open-source softwares.
